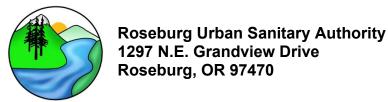

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ROSEBURG URBAN SANITARY AUTHORITY

David Campos, called the regular monthly Board Meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. on July 10, 2024. The Board Meeting was held in-person and remotely broadcast by Zoom® Meeting.

Consideration of the June 12 Board Meeting Minutes

Tom Dole moved to approve the minutes for the June 12, 2024, Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority monthly Board Meeting.

John Dunn seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

Recognition 2024 Best Place for Working Parents Designation

Robin VanWinkle, Early Learning Program Facilitator with the Douglas ESD, presented RUSA with the 2024 Best Place for Working Parents Designation for being a family friendly employer in Douglas County.

Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority Local Contract Review Board

David Campos called to order the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority Local Contract Review Board.

WRF Vehicle and Equipment Storage Building

RUSA received three bids for the WRF Vehicle and Equipment Storage Building. The apparent low bidder turned out to be H3 General Contractors in the amount of \$771,444.

The project engineering firm, Rogers Engineering, and staff have reviewed the bids and found one bid to be unresponsive.

Staff recommended that the Board issue the notice of intent to award the WRF Vehicle and Equipment Storage Building Project to H3 General Contractors in the amount of \$771,444.

John Dunn made a motion for the intent to award the WRF Vehicle and Equipment Storage Building Project to H3 General Contractors in the amount of \$771,444. Tom Dole seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

Stephens Street Improvements

The Stephens Street Improvements are a joint project with the City of Roseburg. RUSA received the bid results from the City of Roseburg just prior to the meeting. It was quickly looked at and the estimated cost to RUSA based on bid items is \$270,397.17. This number has decreased since the initial estimate of nearly \$750,000. The normal process would be for RUSA and the City enter into an Inter-Governmental Agreement (IGA) for the project. The process of how an IGA works was discussed.

Staff recommended that the Board approve entering into an IGA with the City of Roseburg for the Stephens Street Improvements with the understanding that Staff will fully review the estimated cost prior to signing the agreement.

Kelsey Wood made a motion to approve Staff entering into an IGA with the City of Roseburg for the Stephens Street Improvements.

Tom Dole seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

At this time David Campos reconvened the regular Board Meeting.

General Managers Report

Ameresco - Energy Service Company

RUSA has been noticed that the application for loan to the Department of Environmental Quality's Clean Water State Revolving Fund has been included in the Intended Use Plan 2025 Initial Edition. We are scheduled to meet with the DEQ to discuss adjusting the allocation to meet the current project estimates. In total we have been approved for 9 million in loan, this includes the Cogeneration project that we are not doing at this time.

RUSA has been notified by the Oregon Department of Energy that our applications for the Community Renewable Energy Grant Program have been reviewed and the applications have moved on to the competitive review stage. The award notification is scheduled for September 2, 2024.

RUSA has drafted an Energy Sustainability Plan for your review. Staff would request that the Board approve the plan.

Tom Dole moved to approve the Energy Sustainability Plan as presented.

Kelsey Wood seconded the motion.

The motion passes unanimously.

Deer Creek Siphon Improvements

The Contractor Black Pearl is gathering the required bonds and insurance. The preconstruction meeting is scheduled for Friday, July 12, 2024.

<u>Umpqua Street Sewer Replacement</u>

The contractor is producing submittals for review and approval. Work is scheduled to start July 22nd.

WRF Retaining Wall

Staff are constructing a retaining wall at the WRF to provide additional area for the Solar Array that is planned to be constructed in the summer of 2025. The staff have completed the construction of the wall that is approximately 145 feet long and 12.5 feet in height utilizing 104 super blocks. The remaining back filling to the new grade will be completed as soil spoils are available.

Storage Building

Bids were opened July 2nd and read aloud. The apparent low bidder was H3 General Contractors after review of the bids, and one was found to be unresponsive.

Bisulfite SCADA System

The contractor, Sims Electric, is working on submittals for approval. The SCADA panel has been approved for construction and has been ordered from Con-Vey.

RUSA Office and Garage Reroofing Project

The contractor, Roseburg Roofing and Supply Company, submitted Application for Payment, Pay Estimate #2. The application is in the amount of \$42,000. The requested pay estimate is \$39,900 which is \$42,000 for the work completed this period less \$2,100 in retainage.

The project Architect and staff have reviewed the application and agree that the amount of work completed exceed the requested amount.

We would recommend that the Board approve payment of Pay Estimate #2 in the amount of \$39,900.

Tom Dole moved to approve Pay Estimate #2 in the amount of \$39,900.

Kelsey Wood seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

Jacobs Plant Operations Report

Dan Prather advised that the treatment facility averaged 97% BOD removal and 96% Total Suspended Solids removal during June. The total Effluent flow was 85.61 million gallons all of which went to the NTS at Outfall 002.

Plant Staff continued Pretreatment Activities.

Accounts Payable

The Board reviewed the Accounts Payable Report and Addendum for the July 2024 Accounts Payable and there were no questions.

Kelsey Wood made a motion to approve the Accounts Payable Report and Addendum as presented.

Tom Dole seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

Other Business

There is river rock at the WRF solar site that is left from the old trickle filter that needs to be removed. Knife River has expressed interest in the rock including loading and hauling away. Staff recommends that the rock be sold at \$1 per yard, the previously approved price years ago, and the Board agreed that was a good price since Knife River would be loading and hauling the rock themselves.

The RUSA Summer Picnic was held on June 29, 2024. Kelsey Wood and Tom Dole attended as well as several RUSA staff and their families.

Feedback from the Rate Increase Mailing was discussed including the Editorial, Facebook comments, Newspaper article and direct from customers.

Heat related power outages were discussed, so far there has only been one Demand Response request to shut down the NTS for 2 hours, but otherwise all facilities were fully functional during the heat wave. All facilities are prepared for any outages that may occur with generators on-site and ready for use.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:07 p.m.

Re: General Managers Informational Report to the Board

Ameresco - Energy Service Company

RUSA and Ameresco have been working with the Department of Environmental Quality on the approved projects for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund. We are asking that the Cogeneration project be dropped from the approved projects as the return on investment is not favorable. We have requested that the amount for project No. 78820B-24 (WRF Solar) be increased from \$1.5 million to \$4 Million. We are also requesting the floating solar at the NTS be removed from the current list of projects. We have resubmitted the NTS Floating Solar as a separate project for construction in 2026.

We have been notified by the Oregon Department of Energy that our applications for the Community Renewable Energy Grant Program have been reviewed and the applications have moved on to the competitive review stage. The award notification is scheduled for September 2, 2024.

Deer Creek Siphon Improvements Project No. 23001

The Contractor Black Pearl has submitted the required bonds and insurance. We have executed a contract with Black Pearl. The contractor is submitting the required submittals and is tentatively scheduled to begin work August 19th, 2024.

Umpqua Street Sewer Replacement Project, No. 24001

The Contractor, Northcore has started work. The work must be completed September 27th, 2024.

Stephens St. Improvements Project, No. 24003

The City of Roseburg has received bids for the SE Stephens Water Main Replacement Project. The low bidder was Cradar Enterprises and was awarded the project. The sanitary sewer improvements totaled \$270,397.17. Staff have reviewed the unit prices and total cost and agree with the City's calculations.

Storage Building Project No. 24005

The Contractor, H3, has started the work. The work must be completed December 31st, 2024. The Contractor has submitted payment request No. 1. The work completed this period is valued at \$25,660, with \$1,283 in retainage for a payment request of \$24,377. The project Engineer, Tom Rogers, and staff have reviewed the request and recommend that the Board approve payment request No. 1 in the amount of \$24,377.

Bisulfite SCADA System Project No. 24006

The contractor, Sims Electric, has started the work on this project. The work must be completed October 31st, 2024. The Contractor, Sims Electric, has submitted pay request No.1. The work completed this period is valued at \$76,500, with \$3,825 in retentions for a payment request of \$72,675. The project engineer, Alan Chang, and staff have reviewed the request and recommend that the Board approve payment request No. 1 in the amount of \$72.675.

Office and Garage Reroofing Project No. 24007

The contractor, Roseburg Roofing and Supply Company, submitted Application for payment request No. 3. The work completed this period is valued at \$6,554.50, with \$327.73 in retainage for a payment request of \$6,226.77.

The project Architect, Curt Wilson, and staff have reviewed the request and recommend that the Board approve payment request No. 3 in the amount of \$6,226.73.

Manhole Rehabilitation Project, No. 24009

RUSA has received a quotation for the rehabilitation of ten manholes as part of our annual manhole I&I reduction project. The total cost is \$49,902.60.

Staff will be evaluating increasing the funding for this ongoing project as we are seeing good results.

The Contractor, Roseburg Roofing submitted the draft of Pay Application 3 on July 25, 2024. We meet on site with a representative of Roseburg Roofing on July 26, 2024 to discuss status of project submittals, and to review the progress of the work.

Review of Work

- Generally, the membrane work is complete on the all surfaces.
- Sheet metal cap flashing has been installed, however more work is necessary to complete
- The manufacturer's field inspection has been requested and should occur soon.
- The walk-off pads will be installed per the drawings after the manufacturer's inspection is complete.
- Other work to complete includes: Safety line connected to roof anchors, misc sheet metal and wood trim, and other punch list items.

The amount completed and stored to day, prior to adjustment for retainage of , \$196,754.50, is 95% of the contract amount of \$207,110. In my professional judgement, the actual percentage of the work performed exceeds the requested amount, therefore I recommend accepting this pay application and pay the amount of \$6,226.77. • All permit parameters were met this month.

- The treatment facility averaged 98% BOD removal and 97% Total Suspended Solids removal during the month with a requirement of no less than 85% removal for each.
- The facility's electrical consumption (based on meter readings) for July 2024, was 225,000 KWHRS with a total Effluent flow of 85.22 million gallons, all of which went to the NTS at Outfall 002. The July 2023 electrical consumption was 246,000 KWHRS with a total Effluent flow of 70.77 million gallons, all of which went to the NTS at Outfall 002.
- Roseburg Refrigeration serviced the HVAC systems at the NTS and the plant.

PRETREATMENT ACTIVITIES

Mailed out 10 Pretreatment surveys to local businesses.

The following pretreatment inspections were completed in July:

- Fred Meyer: Their interceptor tank is at 20% in the final tank, no fog in the clean out.
- Little Cesar's Pizza: At the manhole behind the building, some FOG in the line.
- Java Run, Harvard Ave: At the clean out, very little FOG.
- Gathering Grounds: At the clean out, there was a small amount of FOG in the piping.
- Dairy Queen: Tank was 15% full using the sludge judge.

NATURAL TREATMENT SYSTEM (NTS)

- The NTS pumps were shut down for a power shaving event as requested, for 2 hours.
- An electrofusion repair was done on 2H.
- Alum injection at the outfall started this month.
- High zone irrigation was reduced to maintain pond level above a low-level cut-off.

MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

- Maintenance Team completed **765** Preventative Maintenance items for the month.
- Maintenance Team completed **16** Corrective Maintenance items for the month.

- The Eureka probes are placed in SW1, SW5, and SW6, to continuously monitor pH, Temp., and D.O.
- Also included for the summer is Total Phosphorus (PO4) for the NTS, which is sampled at SW1, SW5, and SW6 once a week and once a month at MW1.
- TKN and Nitrite-Nitrate are tested weekly for SW5.
- Ammonia is tested for at SW5 once a month.
- When discharging from the pond we sample daily for PO4 at SW5.
- Number of Tests for permit: 138
- Eureka probes were calibrated and deployed at SW1, SW6, and SW5, on July 3rd and on July 18th Probes were pulled, downloaded, and recalibrated and redeployed.
- On July 10th lab water was sampled and sent out to NRC.
- Entered DMR-QA data on ERA E-Data for grading.

BIOSOLIDS

Both liquid and dewatered biosolids were hauled to two different sites.

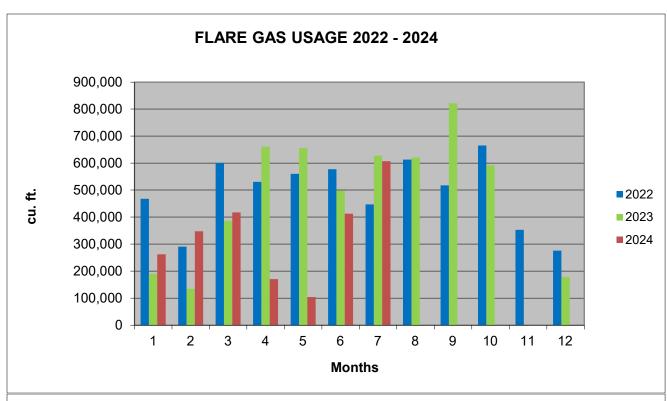

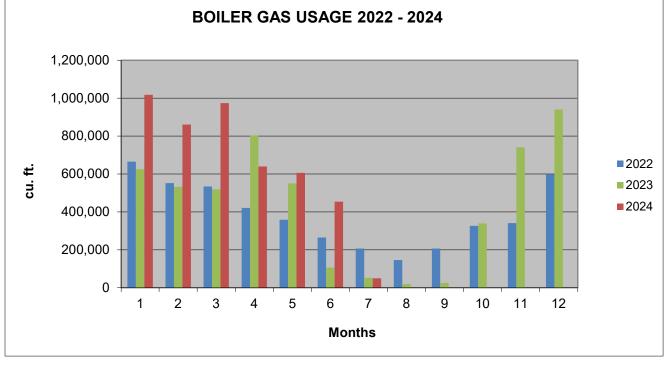

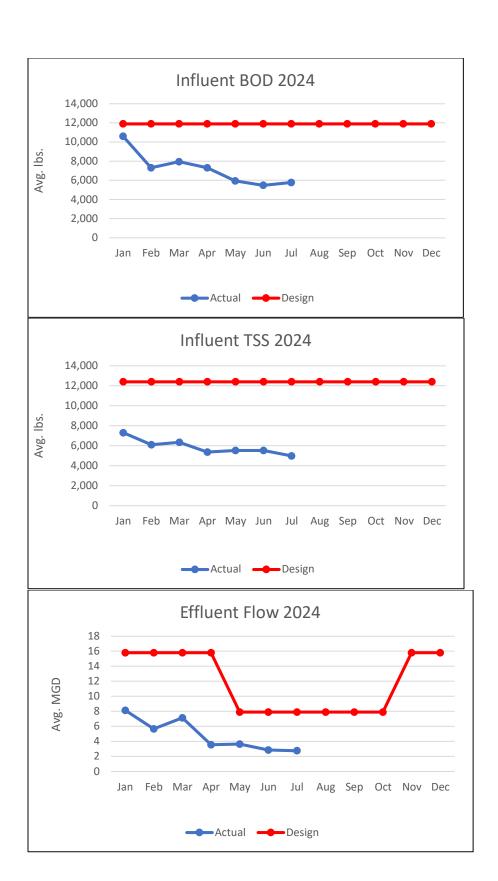
